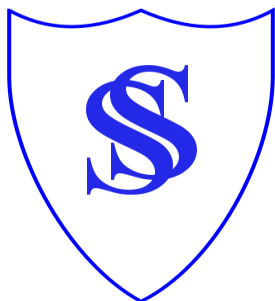

PE: On **Tuesday and Thursday**, the children are required to wear the correct kit and have a water bottle too.

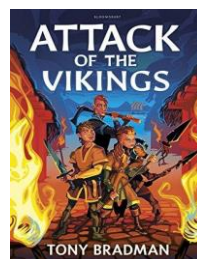
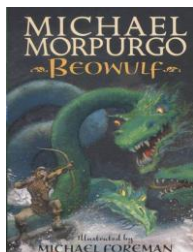

Weekly homework which must be completed by all pupils.




Homework will handed out each Wednesday and must be completed by Tuesday
